A question was asked regarding the availability of grants for the building of a lake to help alleviate the flooding issues experienced in the Burford Bridge area. Cllr Matthissen confirmed that when he had asked for landowners to come forward if they were interested in helping with a project such as this no one replied. He also confirmed that there may well be grants available for environmental benefits/improvements and a lake such as this would probably fit the criteria. It was agreed that further investigation of the possibilities of a project be tasked to the Parish Council and an item will be added to a future agenda. Cllr Matthissen confirmed that he would source the tributary and river maps and target landowners again.

Concerns were expressed regarding a path over a ditch in Woodpecker Hill wood with the suggestion that a railing be installed to make it safer for children. Consideration of this will be added to a future Parish Council agenda.
